The {University Interscholastic League} The {U I L} Rules
along with several Rules Modifications and Policies enforced by the
{COP,T;PARD's;AD}.

2.) Governing Body #2

is The City Of Pasadena, Texas; Parks and Recreation Department's {Athletics
Division} {COP,T;PARD's;AD} and or its Appointed Representatives.
will “GOVERN” both our City Leagues and City Tournaments.

Rules Exceptions and Modifications

1.) The Net Height for

The Wednesday Nights Adult Co – Ed Volleyball

(Competitive Level “Spike League” Division) is:

Seven Feet and Eleven and Five Eighths Inches: (7’ 11 5/8”) High

2.) The Net Height for Both:

a.) The Tuesday Nights Adult Co – Ed Volleyball

(Rec Level “No Spike League” Division) and

b.) The Thursday Nights All Women’s Volleyball

(Competitive Level “Spike League”) is:

Seven Feet and Four and One Eighths Inches: (7’ 4 1/8”) High

3.) Each Volleyball Competition between Two (2) Teams

is called a Volleyball Match.

4.) The Two (2) or The Three (3) Games or Sets

played between Two (2) Competing Teams; to determine a Winner of The Volleyball Match, is No Longer called Volleyball Games;

a.) They are Now Called, Volleyball Sets.

b.) Therefore, The First (1st) Team that Wins Two (2) Volleyball Sets; would be The Winner of That Volleyball Match; either, by Winning, Two (2) Sets, to One (1) Set; or, by Winning Two (2) Sets to Zero (0) Sets.

5.) Scoring is in a Rally Scoring Format.

a.) We use The Rally Scoring Format.

Rally Scoring means that: a Point is Awarded or Scored "Every Time:"

1.) a Team Violation occurs; a Player Violation; occurs; an Errored or Faulted Served Ball; a Successful Serve occurs

2.) Additionally, a Point is Awarded or Scored Every Time a Volley - Rally comes to an End.

b.) Regular Season Match Scoring

1.) In The City of Pasadena, Texas; Parks and Recreation Department: {Athletics Division's} Leagues;

a Team Must Win, The Best Two (2) Out of a possible Three (3) Sets, in order to Win The Volleyball Match.

2.) The First (1st) Team that Wins Two (2) Set, out of a possible, Three (3) Sets; Wins The Volleyball Match.

c.) Regular Season Set Scoring

1.) Set Scoring for Set #1 and Set #2 is: that a Team Must Win by; either, Two (2) or More Points to Twenty One (21) Points; {With a Cap of Twenty Five (25) Points: Maximum Cap};

2.) Set Scoring for The Tie Breaking: Set #3; "IF NEEDED" is: that a Team Must Win by; either, Two (2) or More Points to Twelve (12) Points; {With a Cap of Fifteen (15) Points: Maximum Cap}.

d.) Post Season (Double Elimination) "Play - Offs" Championship Tournament Match Scoring

1.) In The City of Pasadena, Texas' Leagues, a Team Must Win, The Best Two (2) Out of a possible Three (3) Sets, in order to Win The Volleyball Match.

2.) The First (1st) Team that Wins Two (2) Set Out of a possible Three (3) Sets; Wins The Volleyball Match.

e.) Post Season (Double Elimination) “Play – Offs” Championship Tournament

Set Scoring

1.) Set Scoring for Set #1 and Set #2 is:

that a **Team Must Win By**, either, Two (2) or **More Points**
to Twenty Five (25) **Points**;

{**With a Cap of Thirty (30) Points: Maximum Cap**}

2.) Set Scoring for The Tie Breaking: Set #3; “IF NEEDED” is:

that a **Team Must Win** by, either, Two (2) or **More Points**
to Fifteen (15) **Points**;

{**With a Cap of Twenty (20) Points: Maximum Cap**}

6.) Full National Federation of High School Rules {NFHS} Volleyball

are Allowed;

Including: **Jump Serves** and **Spiking** are **Allowed** in **Both** our

Competitive Level Spike Volleyball Leagues

The **Wednesday Nights Adult Co – Ed (“Competitive Level Spike Volleyball League”)** and

The **Thursday Nights All Women’s (“Competitive Level Volleyball League”)**.

a.) A Player is considered to be a Front Row Player,

when He or She is lined up; in **Any** of a, possible,

Three (3) **Front Row Serving Line – Up Order** positions; such as,

The **Font Left** position; The **Front Center** position or The **Front Right** position;

prior to **The Server’s Contacting the Volleyball** on His or Her **Serve**.

b.) All Front Row Players are Allowed to Spike, from Anywhere on the Volleyball Court

when they are considered a **Front Row Player**.

c.) A Player is considered to be a Back Row Player, when He or She is lined up in

Any of a, possible, Three (3) **Back Row Serving Line – Up Order** positions; such as,

The **Back Left** position; The **Back Center** position or The **Back Right** position

prior to **The Server’s Contacting the Volleyball** on His or Her **Serve**.

d.) All Back Row Players are Allowed to Spike,

Only, when, either, **Standing** or **Jumping** from **Completely Behind** the

Ten Feet (10’) Red Line when they are considered

One (1) of a, possible, Three (3) **Back Row Players**.

7.) Jump Serves and Spiking are “Not Allowed” in our

Non - Competitive Level “No Spiking Allowed” Volleyball Leagues, unless,

That Player Totally has **Both Feet on **The Floor**.**

This would be the case, **Only**, for our:

Tuesday Nights (Adult Co – Ed) Volleyball League

“Recreation Level “No Spiking Allowed.”

8.) **Jump Serves and Spiking are “Allowed”** in our **Competitive Level “Full Spiking Allowed” Volleyball Leagues.**

a.) **Any** of a possible Three (3) **Front Row Players**

are Allowed to **Spike** from any area of the court.

b.) **And, Any** of a possible Three (3) **Back Row Players** are **Allowed to Spike**, if He or She **Jumps From Completely Behind The Red Ten Foot (10’) Line.**

c.) This would be the case for both our:

Wednesday Nights Adult Co – Ed

(**“Competitive Level Full Spiking Volleyball League”**); And, for our

Thursday Nights All Women’s (“Competitive Level Full Spiking Volleyball League.”)

9.) The following information explains the **Number of Eligible Players,**

{per Gender} that are **Needed in Their Team’s Serving Line – Up Order**

to; either, **Start; Continue;** or, **End,** a **Volleyball Match,**

a.) These are Six (6) on Six (6) **Adult Co – Ed Volleyball Leagues.**

b.) Therefore, **Each Team** should have:

Three (3) **Males** and Three (3) **Females** on the volleyball court.

c.) Of Course, there is **No Maximum Number of Female Players**

that are allowed to be in **Each Team’s Six (6) Players Serving Line – Up Order Slots.**

d.) **Each Team’s Serving Line – Up Order Slots:** Numbers One (1) through Six (6)

Must Be in an **Alternating Gender Order.**

e.) It can be either:

Male, Female; **Male,** Female; **Male,** Female; or, **Vice Versa:**

Female, Male; **Female,** Male; **Female,** Male.

f.) **All Teams Must Use** an **“Alternating Gender” Serving Line – Up Order;**

regardless if they are using a Four (4) **Players;** Five (5) **Players** or Six (6) **Players**

Serving Line – Up Order.

g.) **Teams** are **Not Allowed** to have Two (2) or **More Male Players** in a **Row** or

in **Consecutive Order** in **Their Serving Line – Up Order Slots.**

h.) If a **Team Loses** One (1) or Two (2) **Players;** such as, **The Number Six (6) Slot;** and or,

even **The Number Five (5) Slot** and, a Six (6th) **Player** or **Players**

in **Their Team’s Serving Line – Up Order,**

Due To Any Type of Disciplinary Reasons or **Incidents;** and,

Do Not Immediately Have the

Correct Gendered Legal Sub or **Subs** to **Replace Them;**

they could **Continue** to **Play** with Four (4), if,

they still have a **Minimum** of Two (2) **Females.**

- i.) However, **Each Time** that or those **Vacated Serving Line – Up Order Slots** comes up in **The Serving Position** or **The Back Right Position**; it would **Side Out** and an **Automatic Point** would be **Awarded** to **Their Opponents**.
- j.) In such a case, **The Team** that is **Awarded a Point**, would then, **Rotate** and **Serve** the **Volleyball**.
- k.) **Even, if**, another **Player, Players** or a **Group** of **Other Teammates**, in general, **Do Not Get Ejected**; but, had a **Disciplinary Issue** or **Issues** with **Any** of our **Sports Officials** or **The Opposing Team**; and possibly, causing; either, One (1) or Two (2) of **Their Team’s Serving Order Line – Up Slots** to become **Vacated**; **Their Slot** or **Slots** in **The Serving Order Line – Up Slot** order; would still, **Side Out** and have an **Automatic Point Awarded** to **Their Opponent**, **Each** and **Every Time**, “**That Slot** or **Those Slots**” **Rotates** into **The Serving Position** or into **The Right Back Position**.
- l.) “**This Rule**” is in **Effect** for **Disciplinary Reasons, Only!!!!!!!**
- m.) And, “**This Rule**” is **Not For Teams** that are **Short Players** and is **Not For Players** that may have to **Leave Early** for any **Other Non – Disciplinary Circumstance!!!!!!!**
- n.) **The Minimum Number of Players** that **Each Team Must Have** In order to **Prevent a Forfeit**, is; Four, (4), with a **Minimum Number** of Two (2) **Female Players**, to **Start**, to **Continue** and or to **End Each Set**.
- o.) **The Serving Line – Up Order Slot** is either: a Six (6) **Players**; a Five (5) **Players** or a Four (4) **Players, Serving Slots**; **Serving Line – Up Order Slot**; that **Must Be Turned In**, to the **Scorekeeper / Clock Operator**, prior to the **Start** of each of the Two (2) or possibly, Three (3) **Volleyball Sets**, per **Volleyball Match**.
- p.) **No Team** is **Allowed** to **Ever Have More Males** than **Females** on the **Volleyball Court** in **Any** of our **Adult Co – Ed Volleyball Leagues**.
- q.) On the other hand, **Every Team** is **Always Allowed** to have a **Complete Ten (10) Player Maximum Team Roster** of **Females**, as well as, is **Always Allowed** to have a **Full Six (6) Players** of the **Female Gender** on the **Volleyball Court**, in **Any** of our **Adult Co – Ed Volleyball Leagues**.

10.) The Serving Line – Up Order Slots

is simply, the chosen Rotating Line - Up Order for Each Specific Player or Each Players' Serving Slot in the Rotating Serving Order that would correctly rotate into the Right Back position; to Serve when His or Her Serving Line – Up Slot, eventually rotates into that Right Back serving position.

11.) This allows Each Team's Team Manager to strategically select the exact order that he or She would like His or Her Players to serve,

12.) Most Teams standardly set their Serving Line – Up, with Their Best Server in The Number One (#1) Serving Slot and Their Worse Server in The Number Six (6) Serving Slot or The Last Serving Slot of Their Team's Serving Line – Up Order Slot.

13.) Each Team will Rotate Clockwise Each Time they are Awarded a Point, Following The Opposing Team's Serve; Including, on their Very First (1st) Serve of Each Set, when Their Opponent Starts the Set off Serving to them.

14.) When The Serving Team Scores a Point, they would, obviously, Not Rotate; because, by winning that point, That Team's Current Server is also Rewarded an Additional Consecutive Serve, far; as long as, an Additional: Consecutive Point or Consecutive Points are Scored or Awarded.

15.) Eligible Substitute Players or Subs

How and When Subs are Allowed to Enter and Exit Each Set

- a.) Please keep in mind; that, Multiple Players could Sub in, for Any of These; either:
a Six (6) Players' Serving Line – Up Order Slots,
a Five (5) Players' Serving Line – Up Order Slot or
for a Four (4) Players' Serving Line – Up Order Slot position.
- b.) However, Once a Substitute Player Enters the Volleyball Set, He or She is, Now, Officially Tied to The Player that He or She Replaced and Any Additional Player or Players that Enter That Set in That Same Serving Line – Up Order Slot Position, for the Duration or the Rest of That Set; but, Not for the Rest of That Match.

- c.) Please keep in mind; that, **Each Player**, Including:
Starting Players and **Substitute Players**; are **All Tied To** or is **Tethered To**
One (1) of **The Six (6) Slots** in **The Serving Line – Up Order Slot**.
- d.) **Normally, Each Team** is **Allowed** to have
Fifteen (15) **Total Substitutions**, per Set.
- e.) However, in **The City of Pasadena, Texas**;
Parks and Recreation Department; {**Athletics Division's**} **Leagues**;
we **Allow** an **Unlimited Number of Substitutions**, per Set,
instead of, a **Total** of Fifteen (15) **Subs Allowed**, per Set.
- f.) **The Primary Reason** or **The Main Reason** **Why Most Leagues**
choose to use **The Unlimited Number of Substitutes System**; instead of;
The More Commonly Known Fifteen (15) **Total Team Substitutions System**, per Set;
is so that **Their Sports Officials** and
Their Teams Do Not Have To Track It or Keep Up With It.
- g.) Even with **The Unlimited Number of Subs System** being used in our
Volleyball Leagues; **Most Teams** will **Very Rarely Substitute**
More Than Ten (10) Time, in One (1) Set.
- h.) Although, **Each, Starting and Substituting Player** is
Tethered to **The Exact Serving Line - Up Order Slot**, which is determined, as,
Each Individual Player Initially **Enters Each Set**; either, as
a **Starter** at the **Start** of a **Set**; or, as, a **Substitute** that does not **Start The Set**; but,
Enters The Set, at **Some Point, Prior To That Set Ending**.
- i.) When **Any Substitute Player** **Subs** into **The Set**; He or She **No Longer**
has to **Remain** in **The Set** for a **Full Six (6) Slots Serving Rotation**.
- j.) Additionally, **All Players** “**Can Now**” **Sub In** and **OUT**, **At Any Point** and **Time**,
Throughout the Duration of Each Volleyball Set.
- k.) **Any Late Arriving Eligible Sub** or **Subs** are **Allowed** to “Initially”
Substitute into **Any Position** or Any Slot in **Their Team's Serving Line – Up Order Slot**
when He or She enters **The Set**,
like any other **Sub**; just prior to entering **Each Set**.

16.) No Jewelry is allowed; except for **very special circumstances!!!!!!!**
Such as, in our, **Adult {Co – Ed} Volleyball Leagues** and
in our **Women's Volleyball ball League**.

17.) Uniform Compliance Policy Rule for Jerseys / T - Shirts

- a.) **Each Team** **Must Have**, at least, One (1) **Set** of **Jerseys / T-Shirts**;
with **Numbers** on “**Both**” **The Front** and **The Back** of Each Player's
Jersey T – Shirts.

- b.) **Each Team**, Only Needs to have One (1) **Set of Jersey / T – Shirts**.
- c.) **Each Team’s Set of Jersey / T – Shirts**, can be **Any Color** that they **Prefer**; because, in our **Volleyball Leagues** we do not have **Any Duplicate Color Restrictions**.
- d.) **Each Team** has One (1) **Week**; **The First (1st) Week** of the season to get their (Jerseys / T-Shirts) in **COMPLIANCE** with our **Leagues’ Uniform Policy**.
- e.) Starting in **The Official Games Playing Week Number Two (2)** of the Season, **Each Team Must Have** their Jersey / T – Shirts in **Compliance** with our **Leagues’ Uniform Policy**; or, **Their Team** would have to **Forfeit** Each Volleyball Match for failing to **Comply** with our **Uniform Policy Rule**.

18.) The Visiting Team’s Bench is now **Located** on the **Near - Side** or the **North - Side** of the **Gym**, as you enter the **Gymnasium Facility**; and, would; therefore, have their **Pregame Warm Ups** on the that **Same - Side** or the **Gym**.

19.) The Home Team’s Bench is now **Located** on the **Far - Side** or the **South - Side** of the **Gym**, as you enter the **Gymnasium Facility**; and, would; therefore, have their **Pregame Warm Ups** on the that **Same - Side** or the **Gym**.

20.) Volleyball Match Time Duration for
The Regular Season

- a.) Our **Adult Volleyball Leagues** normally have; either, a Six (6) **Volleyball Match Nightly Line - Up** or a Seven (7) **Volleyball Match Nightly Line – Up**, per **League Date**.
- b.) Therefore, **Each Volleyball Match** is **Scheduled** in **Thirty Five (35) Minutes Intervals**.
- c.) We play; that **The First (1st) Team** to **Win** **Two (2) Out** of a possible **Three (3) Volleyball Sets, Wins The Volleyball Match**.
 - 1.) **Sets Scoring** for **Set #1** and **Set #2** is: that a **Team Must Win By**, either, **Two (2) or More Points** to **Twenty One (21) Points**; **{With a Cap of **Twenty Five (25) Points, Maximum Cap**}**.
 - 2.) **Sets Scoring** for **Set #3; “IF NEEDED”** is: that a **Team Must Win By**, either, **Two (2) or More Points** to **Twelve (12) Points**; **{With a Cap of **Fifteen (15) Points, Maximum Cap**}**.

**21.) Volleyball Match Time Duration for
The Post Season “Double Elimination” Championship Tournament**

- a.) Our Adult Volleyball Leagues normally have; either,
a Six (6) Volleyball Match Nightly Line - Up or
a Seven (7) Volleyball Match Nightly Line – Up, per League Date.
- b.) Therefore, Each Volleyball Match is Scheduled in Thirty Five (35) Minutes Intervals.
- c.) We play; that The First (1st) Team to Win Two (2) Out of a possible Three (3) Volleyball Sets, Wins The Volleyball Match.
- 1.) Sets Scoring for Set #1 and Set #2 is: that a Team Must Win By, either,
Two (2) or More Points to Twenty Five (25) Points;
{With a Cap of Thirty (30) Points, Maximum Cap}.
- 2.) Sets Scoring for Set #3; “IF NEEDED”
is: that a Team Must Win By, either,
Two (2) or More Points to Fifteen (15) Points;
{With a Cap of Twenty (20) Points, Maximum Cap}.

**22.) Scheduled Volleyball Matches and
The Forty (40) Minutes Early Arrival Times**

- a.) Each Team is Required to Show Up or to Arrive, {At Least},
Forty (40) Minutes Earlier than their
Originally Scheduled Starting Volleyball Match Times;
Prepared to possibly Play; as early as, Thirty (30) Minutes Earlier than their
Originally Scheduled Starting Volleyball Match Times.
- b.) No Team will ever have to play more than Thirty (30) Minutes ahead of their
Originally Scheduled Starting Volleyball Match Time;
UNLESS, Both Teams agree to do so.
- c.) At that point, the New Start Time; becomes, The New Official Start Time for
Each of The Remaining Volleyball Matches for that Specific League Date.
- d.) And, Remember that, Each Team’s Volleyball Match Time is also,
Their Forfeit Time for The First (1st) Volleyball Set of Each Volleyball Match, Only!!!!
- e.) If, A Team happens to Forfeits their First (1st) Set of a Volleyball Match, they would be
Down, to their Opposing Team, One (1) Set to Zero (00).
- 1.) Although That Team would be Down, One (1) Set to Zero (00); they could play the
next Set or Two (2), as needed; if, they have
The Correct Components of Their Team’s Eligible Players
to Compete for the Remaining Duration of that Volleyball Match.
- 2.) In This Case Scenario; the Results would be;
The First (1st) Team that Wins Two (2) Volleyball Sets, would
Win The Volleyball Match, the same, as, any other Volleyball Match.

23.) Standard Scheduling Format

- a.) **Our Schedule** is set up in a Standard Scheduling Format;
and,
it reads like this, from left to right;

Example =

1 vs 2 = **Means**

Team #1 = Modley Crew: is the Visiting Team
vs
Team #2 = The Rascals: is the **Home Team**

- b.) This means that:

Modley Crew (**The Visiting Team**),
vs or travels to
The Rascals (The Home Team).

- c.) Therefore,

The Team that is listed on the

Left Side of the schedule =

{Modley Crew}, would be {The Visiting Team.}

And,

The Team that is listed on the

Right Side of the schedule =

{The Rascals}, would {The Home Team.}

- d.) **Most of the time**, we will Schedule Six (6) or Seven (7)

League Play Volleyball Matches, per **League: Morning, Afternoon or Night.**

- 1.) Don't forget that, All of our League Play Volleyball Matches are

Scheduled in Thirty Five (35) Minutes Intervals.

- 2.) Here is our Standard Nightly Seven (7) Volleyball Match Line - Up.

Match #1 = 5:30PM; Match #2 = 6:05PM; Match #3 = 6:40PM;

Match #4 = 7:15PM; Match #5 = 7:50PM;; Match #6 = 8:25PM or

Match #7 = 9:00PM

24.) Time – Outs

a.) Number of Time – Outs, per Volleyball Set

During The Regular Season

1. Each Team is Awarded One (1) Total Team Time – Out, per Set; that consist of: One (1) Thirty (30) Second Time - Out Duration.
2. If Either Team Attempts to Call a Time - Out when Their Team has already used Their Team's, Lone and Only, Time Out in Any Set; The Match Official should, just simple Ignore it or Definitely Not Acknowledge Their Attempt at Calling or Signaling of Any Additional Time - Out.
3. Therefore, there is No Penalty for Attempting To; either, Signal or Call a Time – Out throughout The Regular Season and The Post Season.

b.) Number of Time – Outs, per Volleyball Set

During The Post Season (Double Elimination)

Play – Offs Championship Tournament

- 1.) Each Team is Awarded One (1) Total Team Time – Out, per Set; that consist of: One (1) Sixty (60) Second Time - Out Duration.
- 2.) If Either Team Attempts to Call a Time - Out when Their Team has already used Their Team's, Lone and Only, Time Out in Any Set; The Match Official should, just simple Ignore it or Definitely Not Acknowledge Their Attempt at Calling or Signaling of Any Additional Time - Out.
- 3.) Therefore, there is No Penalty for Attempting To; either, Signal or Call a Time – Out throughout The Regular Season and The Post Season.
- 4.) Time – Outs “Do Not” carry over into the Next Set or Sets; including: The Tie Breaking: Set Number Three {Set #3}.

25.) We “Will Never” End Any of our Adult Volleyball Matches in a Tie

a.) None of our Adult Volleyball Matches will ever End in a Tie.

b.) We do not use a Time Limit in Any of our Volleyball Sets; including The Possible Third (3rd) and Final Tie Breaking Set. Minutes; until a Team eventually emerges, as the winner of each, Regular Season and Post Season “Double Elimination” Play – Offs Championship Tournament Game.

III. Team Rosters, Eligible Players **and Players' Conduct** **The Resulting Penalties; Disciplinary Actions;** **Team Forfeits; Team or Player Suspensions** **and Team or Player Ejections**

1.) Official Team Roster

- a.) **Each Team Must** turn in an Official Team Roster, by **The Roster's Due Date**.
- b.) **The Roster's Due Date** is always in **Week Two (2)** of Each League, by the end of **Each Specific League: Morning, Afternoon** or **Night**.
- c.) **Each Player Must Have Their** {Official or "**Texas**" Government I. D. Issued Name} on His or Her Team's **Official Team Roster** that is **Due**, by the end of **Week 2's League Play: Morning, Afternoon** or **Night**.
- d.) A **Player** is allowed **Play On** One (1) **Team, Only**, per **League**.

2.) Each Eligible Player on Their Team's Team Roster

- a.) Each Eligible Player is Required to bring Their Texas Government Issued Texas I. D. in case **Another Team files** an **Official Roster Protest**, anytime during the season; **Starting From** **Week Three (3, Until** the end of **The Post Season "Double Elimination" Play – Offs Championship Tournament**.
- b.) Additionally, **Each Player Must Play in Volleyball Matches**; on, at least, Two (2) "**Different**" League: **Mornings, Afternoons** or **Nights**; **In Order** to be **Eligible** for our **Post Season "Double Elimination" Play – Offs Championship Tournament**.

3.) An Eligible Player for The Regular Season

In Order for a **Player** to be **Eligible to Participate** in any of **The City of Pasadena's Adult Volleyball Leagues**, after **Week 1**, **He or She Must Have Their** {Official "**Texas**" Government I. D. Issued} **Name** on His or Her Team's **Official Team Roster** that is **Due** by, the end of **Week 2's League Play: Morning, Afternoon** or **Night**.

4.) **Any Player** that **Is Not** in **Compliance** with **The Eligible Player Definition**, would immediately be deemed, as an **Ineligible Player** and would **Result** in **His** or **Her Team**, **Forfeiting** that **Volleyball Match**, in-which, the **Identified Named Player** or **Players**, in question, had just participated in.

5.) In Order for any Player to be an **Eligible Player** for **The City of Pasadena's Adult Volleyball Leagues' Double Elimination" Post Season Play - Offs Championship Tournament;**

Each Player Must:

have His or Her {**Official** or "**Texas**" **Government I. D. Issued Name**} listed on His or Her Team's **Official Team Roster** that is **Due**, by the end of **Week 2's League Play's: Morning, Afternoon** or **Night**.

6.) Additionally, In Order for Any Player to be an **Eligible Player** for **The City of Pasadena's Adult Volleyball Leagues' "Double Elimination" Post Season Play - Offs Championship Tournaments;**

Each Player Must:

- a.) **One (1); Participate In**, at least, Two (2) "**Regular Season**" **Volleyball Matches**
- b.) **And, Two (2); Must**, also, have **Played On**, at least, Two (2) "**Different**" **Designated League Mornings, Afternoons** or **Nights**; in order to be **Eligible** to participate in our **Post Season "Double Elimination" Play – Offs Championship Tournaments**.

7.) **No Jewelry Allowed Rule**

- a.) **No Jewelry**; except for **very special circumstances!!!!!!**
- b.) A **Player** or **Players** would be asked to **Take Off** any kind of **Jewelry Type of Items** and or to **Leave The Volleyball Set**.
- c.) if, a larger amount of time is needed or required to remove the **Jewelry Type Items**; and, His or Her **Team** would receive an **Official Team Warning** for violating **The No Jewelry Allowed Rule**.
- d.) From that point, on; **That Team** could be **Penalized** for not **Complying** with **The No Jewelry Rule**. for **Each Additional Infraction** throughout the **Remainder** of **That Volleyball Set** and for the **Remainder** of **That Volleyball Match**, as well.
- e.) **Each Time** a **Team** is **Penalized** for **Not Complying** with **The No Jewelry Allowed Rule**, their **Opponent** or their **Opposing Team** could be **Awarded a Point** and **The Serve**, immediately following that **Awarded Point** and their **Team's Line – Up** would **Rotate**, as needed.

IV. Team and Player's Conduct

The Resulting Penalties; Disciplinary Actions; **All Protest, Team Forfeits;** **Team or Player Suspensions and** **Team or Player Ejections**

1.) Protest

a.) **Rules or Policy Protest**

b.) **Roster Protest**

- 1.) **Each Team** is required to turn in a **Team Roster** by the **End of The Night On The Second (2nd) Official League Playing Week**, which is listed as, **Week #3** of the **Regular Season**.
- 2.) **Each player is responsible for producing His or Her Texas Government Issued: Texas Driver's License or Texas I. D.** at **Each Volleyball Match** played, **Starting From** Week Two (2) of the **Regular Season**; throughout the **Duration** of the **Regular Season** and throughout the **Post Season Play – Offs "Double Header" Championship Tournament**.
- 3.) Although our **Athletics Leagues** are **Open to All Participates** with a **State of Texas I. D.** or a **State of Texas Drivers License**;
- 4.) **The City of Pasadena's Sports Leagues** are **Primarily Intended for The Patrons of our Community**; and the surrounding area such as, **The City of Pasadena Citizens** and our surrounding communities.
- 5.) Other Patrons that may happen to live outside of these areas are totally invited to participate in most of our Sports Programs, as well.
- 6.) However, it would be **Their Responsibility to Comply** with **All of our Rules, Regulations and Policies** in order to be **Eligible To PARTICIPATE** in Any of our **Sports Leagues and Tournaments**.

- 7.) Therefore, it is **Each Player's Responsibility** to obtain a State of Texas I. D. so that we can **Properly Identify** each of our **League Participates**.
- c.) Therefore, an **Opposing Team** can **Protest Each and Every Player** on **Their Opponent's Team** during that specific game.
 - d.) **That Team** would need to a One Hundred Dollars (**\$100.00**) **Money Order; Only**, for (**Each Individual Player Protest**).
 - e.) **All Protest Must Be Made Known** to the **Lead Referee**; who, in turn, would direct the **Protesting Team Manager** to our **Scorer's Table** to write up **Detailed**; but, yet, **Concise Information** on **The City of Pasadena; Parks and Recreation Department: {Athletics Division's} Official Protest Form**.
 - f.) At that point, **The Protest Becomes Official** and either **The League Director** or a **League Staff Representative** would inquire **Any Additional Information** from **All Involved Parties**; and would, then; inform **All Parties** on how our **Protest Policy and Procedure Process** would unfold, from that point, on; and, what **Documents** or **Funds** are **Needed** from **Each of Them**.
 - g.) There is a **Protest Fee** of One Hundred Dollars **\$100.00**, by way of a **Money Orders; Only**, per **Protest**; or, in the case of a **Roster Protest**, it would cost **\$100.00**, by way of a **Specific Money Order**; on a **Case by Case Basis**, for **Each Specific Player** that would be in **Question**.
 - h.) **The Team Filing The Protest or Protests** would eventually make the **Money Order** or **Money Orders** out to **The City of Pasadena's Athletic Division** for One Hundred Dollars **\$100.00** for **Each Different Protested Incident**; or, per **Number of Players** that are **Being Challenged**, at that time; and in that **Specific Protest** or **Specific Protests**.
 - i.) However, **Initially**, the **Money Order** or **Money Orders** should not be made out to any person or agency.
 - j.) **The Money Order** or **Money Orders** should be left **Blank**; so that, **The Protesting Team** could have a **Much Easier Time Cashing It**, if or when, they **Win** the **Protest**.
 - k.) If **The Protesting Team** is **Not Correct**, and **Loses Their Protest**, they would then, **Forfeit** that **Protesting Fee** to **The City Of Pasadena; Parks and Recreation Department's {Athletics Division} {COP,T;PARD's;AD} League**.
 - l.) Of course, if **The Protesting Team** is **Correct**; and **Wins Their Protest**, at that point, **The Money Order** would be **Immediately Returned** to Them, per **Winning Protest!!!!!!**

2.) Suspended and or Expelled Players and or Teams

- a.) If a Player is charged with an **(Unsportsmanlike Conduct Penalty)** or a **{BAD Attitude Penalty}**, **SUCH AS ANY TYPE OF FLAGRANT INFRACTION** or **Bad Foul Language**, in a **MATCH OFFICIAL'S JUDMENT**; a **Point** would be **Awarded to the Opposing Team** along with **The Serve**.
- b.) Additionally, **The Player** or **Players** that was **Charged** with **The Infraction** or **Infractions** could and **More Than Likely, Would Be Ejected!!!!!!!**
- c.) **The Opposing Team** would be **Awarded One (1) Point**, per **Infraction** **"Plus" The Serve**; and, of course, would **Rotate**, as needed.
- d.) Any **Player** or **Players** that are **Ejected From The Volleyball Match** **In The First (1st) Volleyball Set**, would be **Ineligible to Participate** in **The Rest of That Volleyball Match**; **"Plus"**, **One (1) More** or **An Additional Volleyball Match**, as well; of which, would be the **Very Next Scheduled Volleyball Match** that **Their Team Plays**.
- e.) Any **Player** or **Players Ejected** from a **Volleyball Match** **In The Second (2nd) Volleyball Set** or **Anytime Throughout the Immediate Post Volleyball Match's Greeting Hand Shaking** and **Parting Fist Bumping** and the **Subsequent Final Parting**; would be **Ineligible to Participate** in **Their Team's Next Two (2) Scheduled League Volleyball Matches**; **Regardless**; if, this **Occurs** during the **Regular Season** or during the **Post – Season Play – Offs**; **"Double Elimination" Championship Tournament** with **ABSOLUTELY NO EXCEPTIONS!!!!!!!**
- f.) **All Ejected Players** for **Disciplinary Reasons** would be **Required To, Immediately, Leave the Facility** and its **Surrounding Grounds Areas**, such as, **The Parking Lot Areas** for our **Proactive Precautionary Preventive Safety Measures**.
- g.) **All players** that get **Ejected** from any of our **Volleyball Matches**; **because of Disciplinary Reasons, Must Immediately Leave The City of Pasadena Facilities** and its **surrounding grounds**, such as, **ALL** of its **Parking Lot Areas**.
- h.) Additionally, **Each Ejected Player** **Must Get Authorization** from **The City of Pasadena, Texas; Parks and Recreation Department;** **{Athletics Division's} {COP,T PARD AD}** **League Director** or a **Designated Authorized City Staff League Representative**, prior to getting **Reinstated** to **Resume League Play Participation**, after his or her **Suspension Time** has been **Served**.
