



## Chapter 31 Standard Sign Code

### Sec. 31-8. - Violations and penalties.

- (a) (1) *General.* Any person who shall violate any provision of this chapter shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall, upon conviction by court of competent jurisdiction thereof, be punished by a fine of not more than five hundred dollars (\$500.00) for each violation. Each day in which any violation shall occur shall constitute a separate offense. In addition, the city attorney is hereby authorized to take all actions, both legal and equitable, necessary to assure compliance with this chapter.
- (b) (d) *Work done without a permit.* Any person, firm, or organization installing, erecting, or reconstructing a sign or changing the location of a sign without a proper permit will be assessed an amount twice the applicable permit fees, in addition to any penalties, civil or criminal, which may be assessed as a result of a violation of the terms of this chapter.
- (c) (f) *Signs not currently permitted.* Any sign not permitted under the provisions of this chapter shall be subject to all of the penalties and provisions of this chapter including removal, pursuant to the requirements of section 31-11 of this chapter.

### Sec. 31-9. - Sign applications, permits, and fees.

- (b) *Permit required.* No person shall hereafter erect, takedown, construct, destroy, reconstruct, relocate, remove, alter, or use a sign without first having secured a written permit as herein provided from the City of Pasadena.
  - (2) *Transfer of ownership application.* If a sign owner or maintainer wishes to transfer its interest in the sign to another, the purchaser must make an application for transfer within twenty (20) days after the sale. Upon the payment of the transfer application fee and the prorated portion of the operating fee, a new operating permit will be issued. If application is not made within the twenty (20) days, the application will be considered an application for a new sign and subject to all provisions hereof.
  - (l) (14) For each business premises: one (1) flag of the United States, one (1) flag of the State of Texas, one (1) flag of the City of Pasadena, and/or one (1) corporate flag of the business occupying the business premises. The United States Flag Code, Title 36, United States Code, Chapter 10, as amended by P.L. 344, 94<sup>th</sup> Congress, shall be used as a guideline for the display of the United States flag;
